Syllabus (2010-2011)

Goal:

To introduce driver education topics, including the State of New Hampshire Rules for Driving. This course will follow the New Hampshire Driver Education Curriculum. In-car driving techniques and hands on experience will be a large part of this course. Materials will be presented in a challenging and supportive atmosphere.

Classroom:

Room 504, Smith Hall, Coe-Brown Northwood Academy, Northwood NH 03261

Laboratory:

Each student will meet a total of ten "on road" instruction and observation objectives (lab). All lab time will be arranged by the instructor. Student schedules must be flexible to accommodate lab times. Flexibility in scheduling will only simplify this process.

Grading:

Students must complete this course with an 80 or better to pass and receive credit. Students will be graded on a variety of assignments to include but not limited to: test, quizzes, projects, presentations, media facts, home work and classroom participation. On road instruction will be graded on pass / fail basis.

Attendance: ** New policy as of January 1, 2010

"No classroom instruction shall be missed during any course, except for "good cause" as determined by the instructor, including a death in the family or injury. Absences due to good cause shall not exceed 4 hours" per state rule (Saf-C 3114.04 (e)). Students in violation of this policy may be removed from class (without refund) and credit will be lost. Students may then enroll in another class of their choice. Any and all paid fees will be forfeited. This new policy went into effect as of January 1st, 2010 per State of New Hampshire, Driver Education Rules and applies to any driving school in the state of New Hampshire. This is not a product of Charles M. Whitten School of Driving, LLC or that of Coe-Brown Northwood Academy.

Cancellations:

Should school be canceled for any reason, classroom instruction will also be canceled for that day. Driving and observation times may still be met. You will be notified should this involve you. Any and all missed classroom instruction will be rescheduled. (After school same week)

Class Dates:

There will be one class per marking quarter as agreed to mutually by both Charles M. Whitten School of Driving and Coe-Brown Northwood Academy.

Class Time:

Class starts at 7:00am and ends at 7:45am Monday-Friday. Classes follow the school calendar and will only meet those days that school is in session unless otherwise noted.

Other materials:

Each student must have the following; Pen, Pencil, Highlighter, and a 1 inch three-ring binder. Each student must maintain a well organized binder for Driver Education only. All work including: handouts, quizzes, notes, etc. should be kept in this binder in order to receive full credit. This will help to improve organization and will also facilitate learning.
